Minutes or notes have yet to be found that report the actual “results” of this election, but it can be assumed that perhaps Sandra Hanks (incumbent) was the lone candidate and therefore simply declared (re)elected. Term is January 1, 2000 to December 31, 2002.

ELECTION 1998

David Gendron was the only candidate that took out nomination papers. All of David’s papers were in order and therefore the Election Board accepted David as the new Board member to replace Elizabeth Hollingsworth who did not seek re-election. Term is January 1, 1999 to December 31, 2001. (See notes in board minutes on 11/19/1998.)
